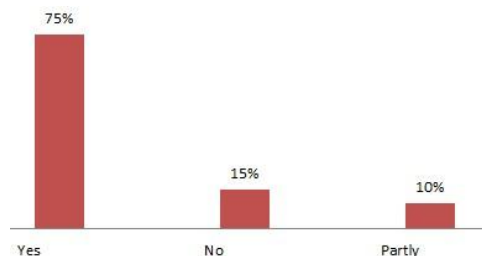
Additional students' preparation

Three VET Schools in Nazilli have had Additional courses for the unsuccessful students, especially who are in risk of drop out. 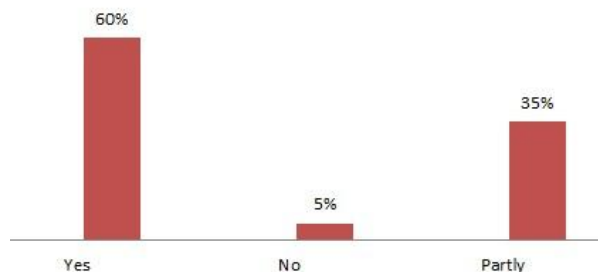
We applied two different questionnaires to students who attend the additional courses and their parents. 40 students and 20 parents in total answered the questions. These are the results:

Parents' questionnaire:

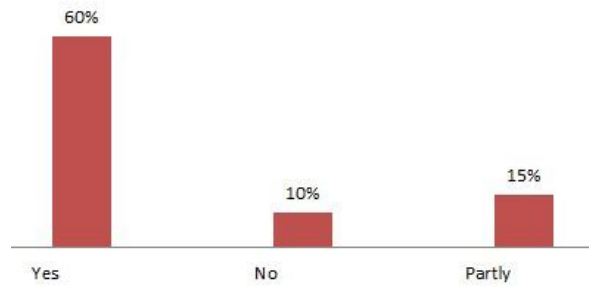
Question 1) Do you think teachers have managed to develop and improve the students' motivation?



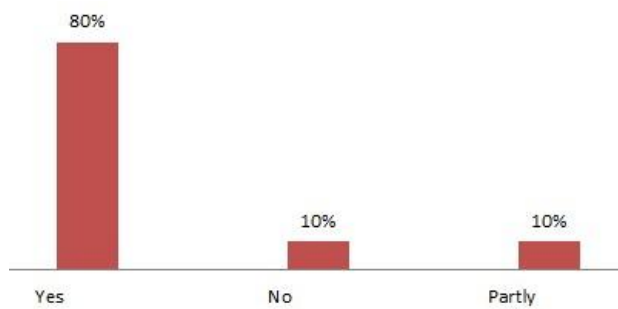
Question 2) Do you consider appropriate the contents of the school subjects offered?



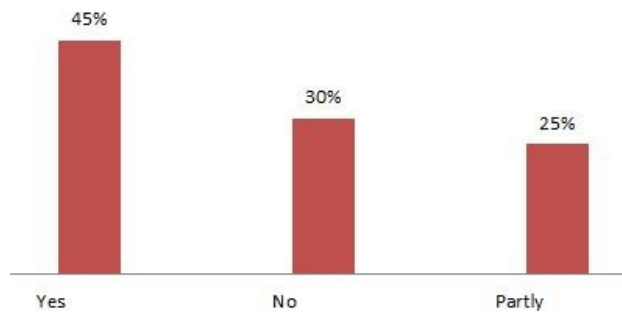
Question 3) Have the school activities of the laboratory and the internship carried out enabled the students to develop relevant professional skills?



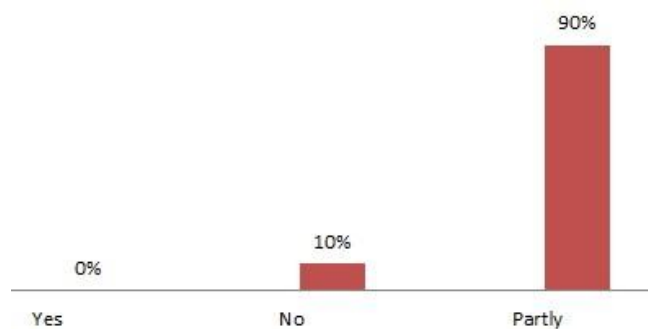
Question 4) Do you find the intermediate/ final school report easy to be understood?



Question 5) Have parents been appropriate involved during the school year (meetings....) ?

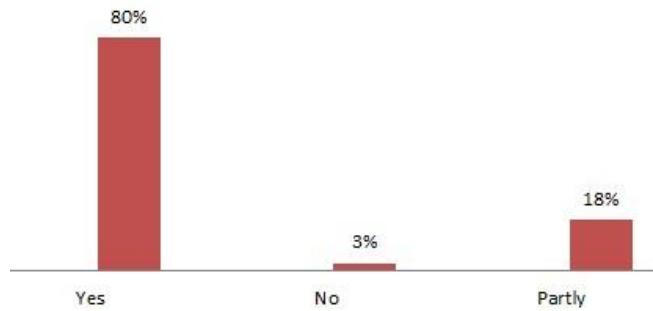


Question 6) Do you know about phenomena related to bullying, vandalism or other violent behaviors in the course attended by your son/daughter ?

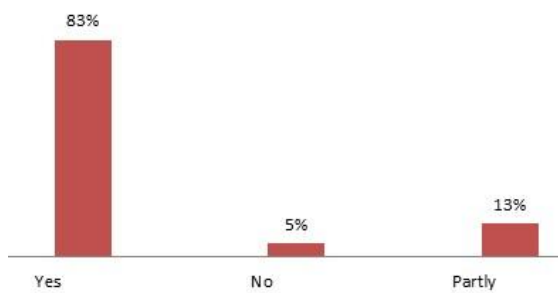

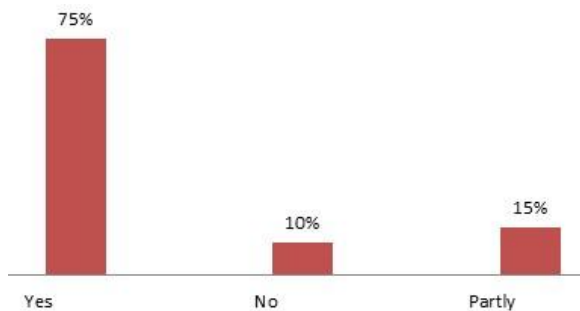
Question 1) Will teachers be useful for your future?



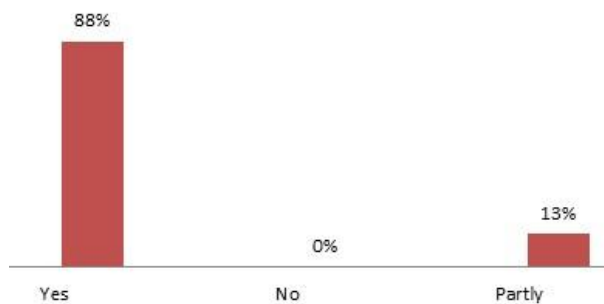
Question 2) Did you feel good in class with classmates and teachers ?



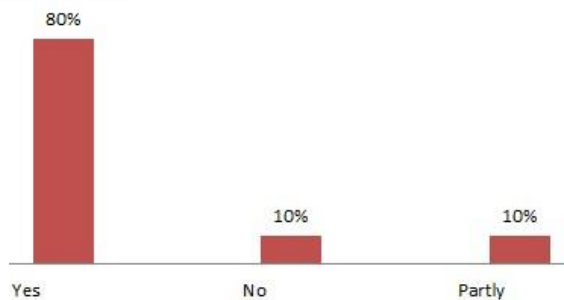
Question 3) Are you satisfied with your goals ?



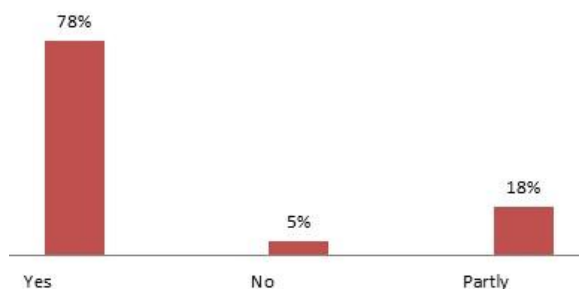
Question 4) Has the tutor been useful ?



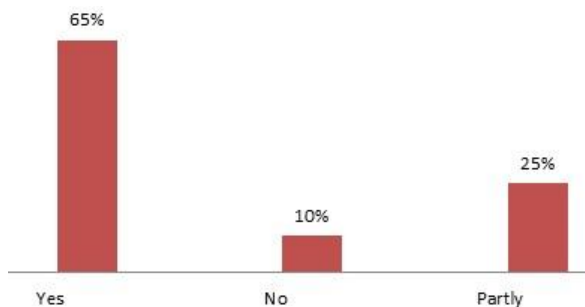
Question 5) Do the teachers speak clearly, do you understand them easily?



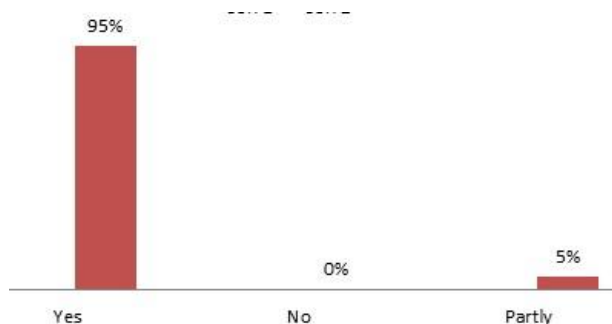
Question 6) Do the teachers take into consideration your personal school interests?
